



Boarding Information

Monday THRU Friday: Drop off your pet after 7:00am until 6:00pm. Saturday: Drop off your pet after 7:00am until 3:00pm.

Monday THRU Saturday: Pick-ups are after 4:00pm until 9:00pm

• THERE ARE NO PICK-UPS OR DROP OFFS ON SUNDAYS OR HOLIDAYS •

We ask that you always call first to make sure your pet is ready to be picked up.

Other information regarding our boarding facility:

- 1. All pets are kept inside air-conditioned kennels.
- 2. All canines are walked outside 4 to 5 times daily weather permitting.
- 3. All pets if found to have any parasites (flea, ticks, worms.. etc.) will be dewormed or treated topically due to the possibility of contamination to other pets. *This will be at an additional charge to you.* Our front desk will be happy to explain all the fees.
- 4. All pets will be given a Capstar upon arrival and discharge to prevent contamination to other pets.
- 5. All pets are required to be current on all vaccinations. If your pet is due or we are unable to verify, *your pet will be vaccinated*. The vaccines and their explanations are listed below.
- 6. All pets are bathed prior to their release at a discounted rate. If you do not want this service, you may decline the bath.
- 7. There will be a \$6.00 charge per day/per medication supplied by the hospital while boarding. Any medication supplied by the owner to be given while boarding will be charged \$3.00 per day/per medication. A fee also applies for any special food we may have to supply. Please check with receptionist.

Feline: FVRCP (distemper): within 1 – 3 years depending on age/boosters

Rabies: within 1 year

Leukemia (optional): within 1 year

Canine: DHLP (distemper): within 1 – 3 years depending on age/boosters

Parvo: within 1 – 3 years depending on age/boosters

Bordatella (kennel cough): within 6 months

Influenza: once a year (boostered 3 weeks after the first) Rabies: within 1-3 years depending on age/boosters
