A Guide to Brushes

There are many different types of brushes available. When choosing what type of brush to use, consider your dog's coat type and length. Then decide what you need the brush to accomplish. The most popular types of brushes are as follows:



Slicker brush – The slicker brush pulls up dead hair or undercoat. It also helps untangle mats and snarls. It is great for use on medium or long hair dogs, or cats with tangles.



Shedding Blades – The shedding blade removes dead hair from the coat. Its best to use in short or medium hair breeds such as a lab. The Shedding blade is designed not only to remove loose hair but also help remove excess water after bathing.



Combs – Combs remove tangles, fluffs and separates hair, and increases volume. Combs are perfect for finishing a coat.



The Furminator – The Furminator reduces shedding up to 90 percent. It removes the loose, dead undercoat without damaging the topcoat. Furminator works great on all shedding, long and short-haired dogs and cats. It also helps to eliminate hairballs in cats!
