Pets coming in through our Emergency service will be seen by a veterinarian in order of priority number.

In order to provide optimal care for our patients and the best experience for our clients, we have instituted the following emergency service schedule*:

7am-9am Priority 1 and 2 patients only 9am-5pm All Priority levels seen **5pm-12am Priority 1 and 2 patients only** Midnight-7am Full deferral of all cases



*PLEASE NOTE: In order to provide optimal care for our patients, at any time, staffing and caseload may dictate the need to make further changes to this schedule.




MAY RECOVER IF LIFE-SAVING MEASURES ARE TAKEN **EXAMPLES:**
