Our fully stocked ambulance is available to transfer critically ill pets, including those needing oxygen, monitoring, fluids, or other requirements to our facility from local veterinary practices. We are ready and able to handle patients from small cats to large breed dogs, and carry special equipment for each type of transport.

The ambulance is available on-call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and responds to all requests as quickly as possible.
